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ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. The Agency should have experience to supply Fully Automated Biochemistry Analyser in State/Central Govt/Autonomous Body or any reputed institution. List of current users in and around Kolkata is to be submitted.
2. The Agency should furnish attested copies of the following documents:-
 - i) Copies of Income Tax/Service Tax returns for the latest three assessment years.
 - ii) Copy of Trade License essential for carrying out the activities under the contract.
 - iii) GST enrolment Certificate.
 - iv) Copy of PAN CARD of the Proprietor/ Partner/Company.
 - v) Copy of GST Return submitted
 - vi) Details of experience with documentary evidence. List of existing users and performance certificate is to be provided

Tender and Contract document for the supply of: 1. Fully Automated Biochemistry Analyser at CNCI, 37, S. P. Mukherjee Road, Kolkata- 700026.

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1. Contents of tender documents

Each set of tender document will comprise followings:

- a) Tender notice
- b) Terms and conditions
- c) Specification for the Equipment/ Machine.
- d) BOQ
- e) Terms and conditions of contract

Attested copies of up to date clearance certificate of professional, tax, trade license and credential certificates should be submitted along with the offer.

2. Estimated cost of work

The work is estimated to an amount of Rs. 50 lakh for the Fully Automated Biochemistry Analyser, This estimate, however, is reflecting a rough guidance.

3. Terms and conditions

1. Prices should be quoted in any standard foreign currency for the country of origin (in words and figures). No correction /deletion/overwriting by the bidder will be entertained. Rates will be inclusive of GST and other taxes, only net price is to be quoted. The percentage and element of duties and taxes included in the price should be specifically stated. Incomplete offer will not be entertained.
2. The tenderers should quote post warranty AMC (Annual Maintenance Contract)/CMC (Comprehensive Maintenance Contract) for five years separately in the closed envelop along with EMD after completion of the 5 years warranty period.
3. Quotations should have validity of 180 Days.
4. Successful bidder will have to make an agreement for maintenance of equipment, provision of service. No work of any kind should be commenced without proper execution of an agreement.
5. Non-fulfillment of the conditions of executing the contract by the supplier would constitute sufficient ground for annulment of the award and forfeiture of EMD.
6. No variation of price will be allowed during the period of contract.
7. The equipment will have to be delivered within a reasonable period of time. No extension of the scheduled delivery/installation completion dates will be granted except events constituting force majeure.
8. All supply of goods must conform to the specification as per tender.
9. **Tenders will be opened at 14.30 hrs on 13.03.2018.**
10. Every effort has been made to put forth general specifications in this tender document. If inadvertently, any of the specifications drawn happens to match with the specifications of any particular firm's product only, in respect of critical parameters, then it will not automatically mean that this particular firm's offer is only technically suitable. In general, the specifications offered by other firms will be assessed in their own entirety to ascertain whether or not the broad functions in general expected of the equipments of the purchaser and accordingly the offers would be considered based on prudent assessment of the purchaser.
11. The successful tenderers will have to execute one contract agreement with CNCI and submit Bank guarantee @ 5% of the contract value duly executed by any of the

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nationalized bank towards security deposit for the aforesaid contract. The said bank guarantee requires to be revalidated if situation so demands. No interest on the bank guarantee will be paid by CNCI. The authority of this institute shall have the authority to forfeit the security deposit (Bank Guarantee money), if the tenderer fails to supply the machine as per the agreed terms and conditions and within prescribed delivery period.

12. Customs clearance procedures/charges and transportation procedures/charges, if any will have to be borne by the supplier/agency and no such charges will be paid by CNCI except the customs duty.
13. The tenderers must have supplied such machine in State/Central Govt/Autonomous Body or any reputed institution. List of current users in and around Kolkata is to be submitted.
14. The tenderers must have authorized service centre within the city limit of Kolkata/ Howrah, for providing after-sales service of the machine. The address, fax, telephone no. should be clearly mentioned on the offer.
15. With regard to interpretation of terms and conditions, the decision of CNCI shall be final and binding to the Bidder.
16. Time for supply: The time allowed for supply of the machine will be within 150 days of date of issue of letter of acceptance.
17. Tenderer requiring any clarification on the Tender Document may notify Director's Office at the address, Chittaranjan National Cancer Institute, 37, S. P. Mukherjee Road, Kolkata-700026/Fax No. 033-2475-7606. The clarifications of questions raised (without identifying the source of enquiry) and the responses given will be transmitted to all tenderers.
18. Addendum/corrigendum, if any, shall become part of tender documents and the same to be submitted by the bidders along with the tender as a token of acceptance.
19. In exceptional circumstances, prior to the expiry of the original time limit for tender validity, the authority may request to tenderers to extend the period of validity for a specified additional period. The request and the tenderer's response shall be made in writing. A tenderer may refuse the request without forfeiting his earnest money. A tenderer agreeing to the request will not be required or permitted to modify his financial bid but will be required to extend the validity of the earnest money for the period of the extension.
20. The tenderers shall submit offers, which comply strictly with the requirements of the tender document. Alteration or any modifications shall render the tender invalid.
21. **Tender opening and evaluation**-The tender opening committee will scrutinize the tender documents for evaluation to determine whether each tenderer conforms to all/most of the terms, conditions and specifications of the tender document without any modification or condition.

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22. Signing of contract agreement

- i. The tenderer whose tender has been accepted will be notified by the authority by issuing a 'Letter of Acceptance'. The 'Letter of Acceptance' will be sent to the company/agency in two copies one of which should be returned promptly by them, duly signed and stamped. The 'Letter of Acceptance' will be a binding contract between the employer and the contractor till the formal contract agreement is executed.
- ii. Within the period specified in Clause 1 of 'Clause of Contract', of the date of issue of 'Letter of Acceptance', the successful tenderer shall submit the security deposit, favoring Director, CNCI, Kolkata.
- iii. The tenderer whose tender is accepted shall be required to submit in stamp papers of appropriate value as per the provisions of Indian Stamp Act by letter of acceptance within 07 days of the date of issue of 'Letter of Acceptance'. The cost of the stamp papers shall be borne by the tenderer.
- iv. At the same time the authority notifies the successful tenderer that his tender has been accepted, the authority will direct to attend at CNCI within 07 (Seven) days of issue of 'Letter of Acceptance' for signing the Agreement in the Proforma to be supplied to the successful bidder.

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SPECIFICATIONS FOR FULLY AUTOMATED BIOCHEMISTRY ANALYSER

1. Must be Floor Model, Fully Open system discrete patient oriented system for Biochemical and ISE investigation.
2. Any reputed (branded) make computer and printer (commercially available in the local market confirming to the analyser specification should be capable of working as a control unit: so as to avoid dependence on spares/consumables of proprietary nature & of imported origin.
3. Throughput of 600 or more Photometric test/hr & additional ISE Test facility must be provided in the same instrument.
4. Types of Assay must be possible: Colorimetric, turbidimetry, ISE (sodium potassium and chloride) etc.
5. Should permit on Board placement of 45 or more reagents (each for R1 & R2)/ tests at one time. All the reagents positions should be refrigerated.
6. Minimum total reaction volume (sample + reagents mixture) should not be more than 120 microlitre. And minimum sample aspiration volume should be less than 1.8 microlitre.
7. O.D. Range should be 0-3.0.
8. More than 150 reaction cuvetts should be in the instrument.
9. Sample position must be minimum 80 or more at a time.
10. Sample probe must have liquid level detection and clot detection facility.
11. Photometric system must be at least 13 wavelength ranging from 340nm-800nm.
12. Simultaneous measurement must be minimum 50 tests at a time.
13. The analyzer must have 3 stand alone probes, 1 for Sample and 2 separate probes for reagent R1 & R2 to avoid any contamination.
14. Data Storage in analyser PC must be minimum 1,00,000.

Other Terms and Conditions:

1. Bidder must provide the required Online UPS (30 minutes back up) along with the analyser.
2. Country of Origin: JAPAN/ USA/ EUROPE are preferable.
3. Must have at least 3 installations of the quoted model in Eastern India.
4. Must offer warranty of 5 years (including computer, printer and UPS except consumables).
5. CMC for 5 years need to be quoted separately (in the separate closed envelop; including computer, printer and UPS except consumables).
6. Buy- Back offer for Existing Automated Chemistry Analyser "Model AU400" & Semi Automated Analyser "Model 9600", Online UPS, PC and Printer should be given.
7. 1 set of startup Reagents i.e. Callibrator's, Control's, ISE related reagents, Glucose, Urea, Creatinine, Alk Phos., SGOT & SGPT etc is to be supplied along with the Instrument.
8. Reagents/Consumables, Control, Calibrator and ISE related reagents consumables price should be quoted separately in the closed envelop. These rates should be valid till the warranty period.
9. Price to be quoted CIP/INR: Customs related documents will be provided by CNCI. Actual customs duty will be reimbursed. Arrangement for custom clearance etc, supply of the machine to CNCI is to be done by the vendor at their own cost.

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
